### **Easton Area High School - (EAHS)**

Using Route 22 east – take Route 22 east to 25<sup>th</sup> St. exit, make right off of the exit, high school is on the right

Using Route 22 west – take Route 22 west to 25<sup>th</sup> St. exit, at stop light turn left onto Route 248/25<sup>th</sup> Street, go straight through 2 stop lights and make right into high school parking lot

Using Route 33 south – take Route 33 south to Route 22 east, take 25<sup>th</sup> St. exit, make right off of the exit, high school is on the right

Using William Penn Highway – take William Penn Highway east, high school is on your left

Using Route 248 south – take Route 248 south to 25<sup>th</sup> St., high school is on your right after passing under Route 22

### **Easton Area Middle School Campus (5/6 and 7/8) – (EAMS)**

Using Route 22 west – take the 13<sup>th</sup> St. exit. Turn left off of the exit, cross the overpass and get into the left lane. Turn left at the stop light. Go to the next traffic light at the top of the hill. Turn left onto Bushkill Drive. Proceed for ¼ mile and make first right turn onto Mitman Road (steep hill). Go up hill and make first right onto Wagoner Lane. Easton Area Middle School is straight ahead.

Using Route 22 east – take the 13<sup>th</sup> St. exit. Stay straight off of the exit to the stop light and get into the left lane. Turn left at the stop light. Go to the next traffic light at the top of the hill. Turn left onto Bushkill Drive. Proceed for ¼ mile and make first right turn onto Mitman Road (steep hill). Go up hill and make first right onto Wagoner Lane. Easton Area Middle School is straight ahead.

### **Riverview Golf Course**

#### From the North of Easton

Route 33 south and get off the Stockertown exit. At top of ramp turn left onto 191. At stoplight turn right onto Main St. Continue down Main St for 2.7 miles (NOTE: Main St. turns into Sullivan Trail in Forks Twsp.). Turn left onto Newlins Rd west (This left is after Lafayette Metzgar Fields & Bradens airport both are on your right). At the first stop sign continue straight on Newlins Rd. west. After this stop sign you will need to bear left to stay on Newlins Rd. west. Continue all the way down Newlins Rd. till you get to a (T). Make a right onto Broadway Rd. Off of Broadway make the 1<sup>st</sup> left onto Winchester Dr. This will lead you to the clubhouse.

#### From the West of Easton

Route 22 East to the 13<sup>th</sup> St. exit. Continue straight at top of ramp to the stoplight. At stoplight make a left onto 13<sup>th</sup> St. Go down 13<sup>th</sup> to the next stoplight. Go straight through light onto Lafayette St. Take Lafayette all the way to the (T) which is the 611 junction (This approximately 1.6 mile to the (T)). Make a left onto 611 N. Continue on 611 for approximately 1.5 miles. After the Riverside Deli store (which is on your left) start to look for Frost Hollow Rd. Make a left onto Frost Hollow Rd. and then the 1<sup>st</sup> right onto Winchester. This will take you to the clubhouse.
